DEPARTMENTS

1. **Fiqh and Usul al-Fiqh:** Introduces students to the study of Islamic jurisprudence and Islamic legal theory. The wide range of courses offered by the Department not only involve mere textual reading and memorization of the juristic legacy but also an analysis of various views and arguments, an evaluation of proof-values underlining each juristic pronouncement, an appreciation of divergent positions, and most importantly contextualization of juristic discourses with the view of providing solutions to juristic needs of Muslims and global world.
2. **Usul al-Din and Comparative Religion:** Promotes the Islamic sciences relevant to contemporary disciplines of study. It develops an Islamically based integrated and holistic approach to education and career. Its niche area is “comparative approach in the study of Islamic Heritage, Thought, and Other Religions on the basis of Usul al-Din.
3. **Quran and Sunnah Studies:** Offers undergraduate and postgraduate programmes that focus on the study of the Divine Revelation in its two forms, the Qur’an and the Sunnah, as sources of knowledge and guidance for Man in his life.
4. **Arabic Language and Literature:** Offers programmes that deal with various aspects of the Arabic language, linguistics and literature.
5. **English Language and Literature:** Offers undergraduate and postgraduate programmes that deal with various aspects of the English language, linguistics and literature.
6. **Communication:** Offers undergraduate and postgraduate programmes that deal with the nature of human communication through various media at the individual and societal levels.
7. **History and Civilization:** Offers programmes that deal with various fields of history and civilization, including ancient civilizations, Muslim history and civilization, Southeast Asian history, Western history and civilization, and the history of reform movements (Islah and Tajdid) in the Muslim world.
8. **Political Science:** Offers programmes that focus on the processes and institutions of societal decision making.
9. **Psychology:** Psychology programme is designed to equip students with the necessary knowledge, skills, abilities, and other characteristics relevant to the needs of the society and world of work.
10. **Sociology and Anthropology:** offers the programme that focus on the study of society and its institutions.
11. **Fundamental and Inter-Disciplinary Studies:** Functions as a service department offering Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Heritage courses to all University students.
